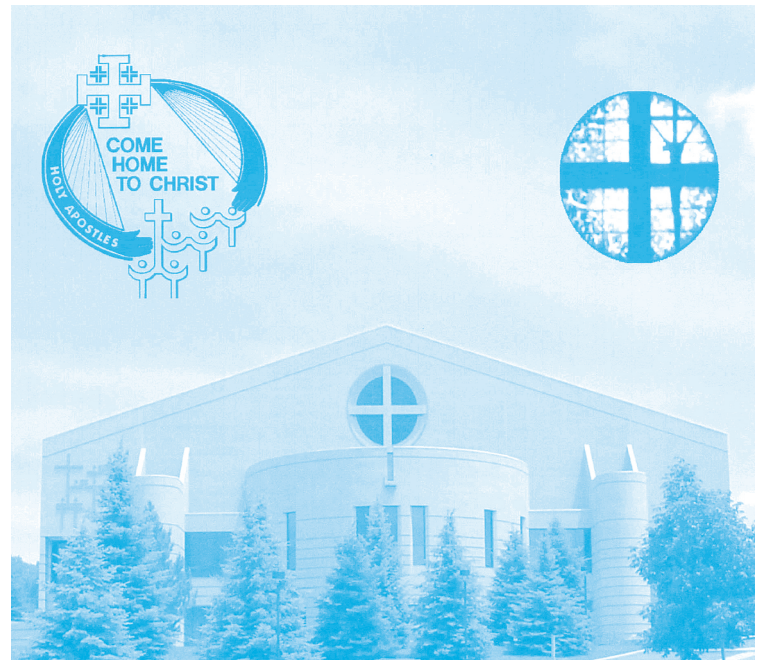

Fr. Paul's Ponderings

"I will not leave You Orphans"

"I will not leave you orphans. I will come to you. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you."

See John 14: 15-21

I'm always challenged when I read the Acts of the Apostles. How was it possible for the Apostles to preach Jesus Christ in the synagogues? To preach Jesus Christ crucified and risen to non Jewish communities in the Roman empire? To risk loss of one's life as disciples of Christ?

And I find myself asking the same questions about my Ukrainian brother priests, bishops, and laity. How were they able to find the daily strength to live as Catholics, to preach and spread the Catholic faith in the face of Soviet enforced atheism? And how can they today courageously continue to rebuild the Catholic Culture in their neighborhoods, cities and nation? And how is it possible for young men to commit themselves to the priesthood in Iraq, Egypt, or Syria?

And the same question for us today in our beloved nation: where do we find the courage to live our faith effectively in our families, confronting the many non-Christian values that invade our homes and relationships? Where do we find the courageous wisdom to speak and act in ways that reveal to others the Christ within us?

Answer to all the above: The Holy Spirit! When the Holy Spirit finds a place in our hearts and minds, we begin to realize that the Holy Spirit comes to us to bring out of us the active presence of Christ! We need not be afraid of others who may orphan us for living our faith. Christ will not leave us orphaned. He comes to us in the power of the Spirit. Christ is in our Father and we are in Christ and He in us.

May we in our families, in our parish family of families, continually experience courageous freedom as disciples of Christ!

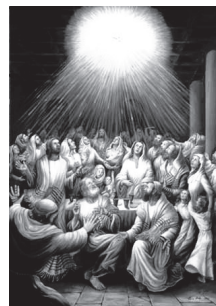


"Upper Room" Pentecost Preparation at the Praise Gathering
